Large math and computer science community












Location

GTU is located on the borders of Istanbul and Kocaeli.


- Marmaray (light rail train) station in the GTU campus
- Marmaray connects the campus to
 - the center of the Asian side of Istanbul.
 - the transportation hubs in the European side.
 - to the whole Asian coast of Istanbul.
- Airports
 - The Sabiha Gokçen international airport in the Asian side of Istanbul
 - less than 20 mins from GTU
 - about 10-15 euros by taxi.
 - The Istanbul Airport is accessible via bus/metro/train (2 changes).
 - 20-25 euros by taxi

- Opened in 2019 3 amphitheaters


- 8 conference rooms Multiple breakout rooms ۰

- Already cooperated for MACIS 2019 successfully.








Conference dinner
