

HOMEWORK – Instructions

Homework problems are assigned for every class period. You need to work on these problems on a daily basis. That is, after each class period, work on the problems corresponding to the material covered that day in class.

There are 2 types of problems: “short answer” and “exercises”. Short answer refers to problems which can be solved basically in one line. However, even then you need to show your work, as shown in the sample solutions are provided.

Some homeworks also list “Concept” questions. You do not need to submit your answer, but be able to answer such questions on quizzes or tests.

The homework problems are given in a .pdf file that includes space to write out the solution. To complete the homework you can choose one of these options:

- Fill in the pdf electronically, for example, using a tablet. Save your result as a pdf.
- Print the homework file, complete it by hand, and scan your result into a pdf file.
- Copy the problems onto blank paper, write out your solutions, and scan your result into a pdf file. Please use the same layout for your writeup as in the original file, that is, use the same number of problems per page. Otherwise it is much harder for the grader to grade your homework.

Once you have created the pdf file with your solutions you upload it into Canvas.

Homework is due at 11:59pm on the given due date. Everyone gets two “life happens” days. Simply let your instructor know (before the due date!) that you need an extension. However, in that case you need to submit the homework before we post solutions, usually within 30 hours of the due date. Any later submissions will only be eligible for 20% completion points, provided they are complete.

Note: extensions cannot be used for homeworks due shortly before exams, for which solutions are posted the next morning.

Solutions to the homework will be posted in Canvas.
